- Removal of hazardous materials in line with current legislation and the Inventory of Hazardous Materials





Inventory of Hazardous Materials

The Inventory of Hazardous Materials (IHM) provides information on the hazardous materials present on board, in order to protect health and safety and to prevent environmental pollution at ship recycling facilities. The IHM accompanies the ship throughout its operating life and incorporates all relevant design and equipment changes, with the final owner delivering the document, with the ship, to the recycling facility. Swansea Drydocks' services include:


- Completing the IHM and coordinating with the ship's classification society
- Making recommendations for ongoing reduction of hazardous materials in line with legislation, policy and end-of-life strategy
- Planned IHM alterations including asbestos removal
- Continual through life management, through to final disposal
